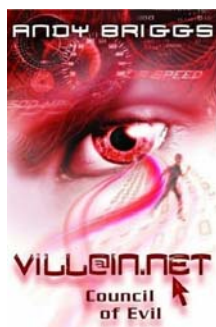

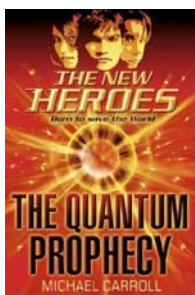
Spy High series by A.J. Butcher

Six teenaged trainees; one school for spies and counter-espionage; a frenzy of action, gadgetry and crazed megalomaniacs. Welcome to Spy High...



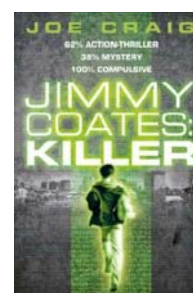
The New Heroes series by Michael Carroll

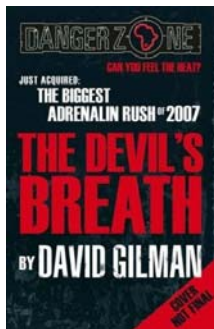


Jimmy Coates series by Joe Craig

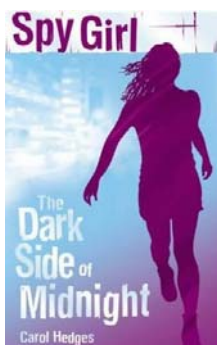
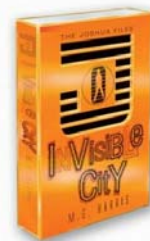


Danger Zone series by David Gilman

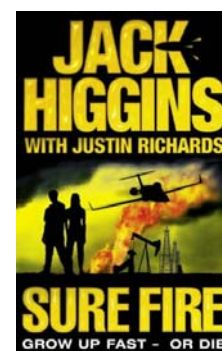


The Dark Side of Midnight by Carol Hedges

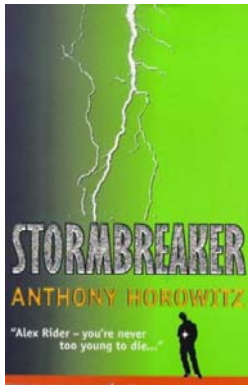


Silver Fin by Charlie Higson

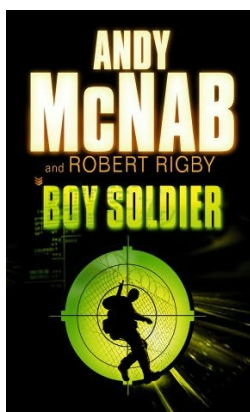
Alex Rider series by Anthony Horowitz

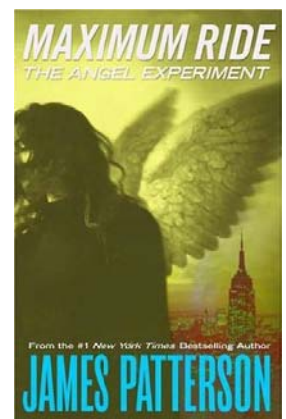
But he knows something the army doesn't seem to know. Fergus Watts is alive and in the UK, living in secret under an assumed name - but where?

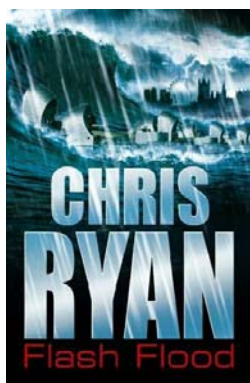
Maximum Ride series by James Patterson

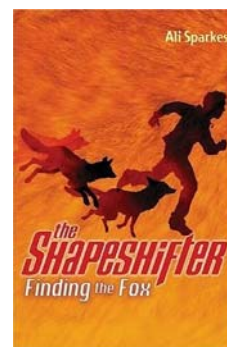
Flash Flood - Part of the Code Red series by Chris Ryan

H.I.V.E. series by Mark Walden

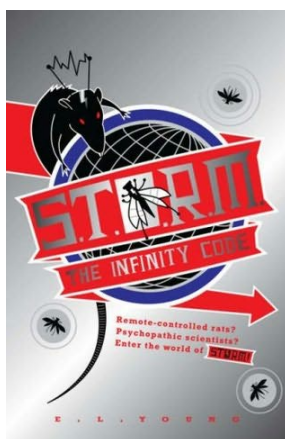
